Worship Ministry Notes

"The LORD, the LORD Himself, is my strength and my defense; He has become my salvation."

Isaiah 12:2

When I was a kid, the worst punishment my mom could deliver was not an immediate spanking or loss of a privilege. No, it was the phrase, "Wait until your dad comes home." Now, my father is truly kind and gentle, and his punishment was no worse than my mom's. But the waiting was torture.

Now that I'm a dad, my girls know well the anguish of impending judgment. And it's almost humorous to see how eager they are to please during this time. Suddenly, they're eagerly cleaning their rooms, picking up their clothes, and asking to help with the dishes. With the coming punishment in mind, they are quick to find favor.

God is the ultimate judge, and while He does not wish for anyone to perish (2 Pet. 3:2), His judgment is absolute. Today, though, the bulk of His judgment is being delayed until Christ's return. In many ways, we are living in a day similar to that of Methuselah, Lamech, and Noah.

Long before the waters rose, God warned that judgment was coming. In fact, Noah's grandfather Methuselah's name even means "when he is dead it shall be sent." Interestingly, after living 969 years, Methuselah died the same year as the flood. Clearly, God delayed judgment so that more might repent and believe.

By the time of the flood, though, "only a few people, eight in all, were saved through water" (1 Pet. 3:20). Why weren't more saved? And why are more people today not concerned with the coming judgment which will be far worse than even a world-wide flood? Why are people not eager to get right with God and escape this impending destruction? Tragically, it's because they do not fear God. They do not believe His word or respect those who do.

Perhaps the greatest challenge before the Church is not convincing people that there's a heaven. It's helping them to see that there is a hell - and that the loving God is still the perfect Judge. He has graciously provided a path to salvation, but we must be willing to admit we need it.

My prayer is that we might be a people eager to sing of His great salvation; that we might joyfully proclaim the redemption found in Christ. Through our witness, may those around us have every opportunity to be saved.


