## Synopsis of Fall Discipleship Classes

**Baptist Faith & Message** (Jonathan Tolbert) - a study of the components of the Baptist Faith & Message 2000 which is the doctrinal statement of Beech Haven. (August 5 - November 25 @ 5:30 pm in Room 249).

**Ready to Launch** (Tommy Fountain) - Based on Psalm 127, this study plumbs the wisdom of the Bible about the goals of parenting, the stages of discipline, the role of the church, and strategies to shape the heart toward the gospel. (August 5 - September 9 @5:30 pm in Room 210).

**Tell Someone** (Matt Rhymer) - a study in the unfailing strategies, methods, and the message that will equip participants in sharing Christ with everyone in their world. (August 5 - September 9 @5:30 in Room 215).

**Financial Peace University** (Mike Campbell) - Dave Ramsey's Financial Peace University will help you take control of your money, plan for your future, and transform your life. (September 16 - November 18 @ 5:30 pm in Room 107)

**Love & Respect** (Ryan Adolphson) - reveals why spouses react negatively to each other, and how they can deal with such conflict quickly, easily and biblically. (September 16 - November 25 @ 5:30 in Room 210)

**Sermon on the Mount** (by Jen Wilkins) (Jessica Crews) - What does it mean to be a citizen of the kingdom of Heaven? Matthew's gospel opens with three chapters containing Jesus' longest recorded message – a sermon given to His disciples early in His ministry to articulate what the life of a Christ-follower would look like. (Sundays, September 9 - November 11 @ 5:30 in Conference Room and Tuesdays, September 4 - November 6 @ 9:30 a.m. in the Fellowship Hall).

**Bible Study Methods** ([Bible Institute](#)) (Chuck Ivey) - An introduction to basic Bible study methods and rules of interpretation with emphasis on accurately understanding and obeying God's Word and the development of practical skills. Students will learn to determine what Scripture says, what it means, and how it can be applied. (August 5 - November 25 @ 5:00 p.m. in Room 247)

**Welcoming Church** (John Walker) - What are we communicating to those who come to our church or Bible study group for the first time? This study will look at what we need to do so those who visit our church don't just hear but also feel the message "you are really welcome here." (August 5 - September 16 @ 5:30 Rm 205).

**Church Ministry, Administration and Education** ([Bible Institute](#)) (Steve Bingham) - An introduction for pastors and church leaders to the basic principles related to the nature, structure and function of the church and to teach the practical knowledge and skills necessary for the local church to effectively carry out its functional roles in the areas of ministry, administration and education.
